

**Declaration to the European Directives  
2002/95/EG (RoHS) Restriction of Hazardous Substances  
2002/96/EG (WEEE) Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment**

With the adoption of the European directives 2002/95/EG (RoHS) and 2002/96/EG from February 13, 2003 concerning the limitation of hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment manufacturing and its recovery, a new legislation has become effective.

The above mentioned directives restrict the use of certain hazardous substances like lead, mercury cadmium or hexavalent chromium used in the manufacturing process of electrical and electronic equipment beginning with July 1, 2006.

viimagic welcomes this regulation and has always sustained the development of environmentally beneficial products and also in future account of the environmental impact will be taken when designing new products. In this sense and as far as available on the market, our products contain RoHs conform components.
